









### **VAPING INFORMATION**

WITH REGIONAL DATA FROM THE RHODE ISLAND STUDENT SURVEY, 2024

More East Bay high school students believe their peers would disapprove of using ENDS- 80% in 2024 vs 67% in 2022.





4.2% of East Bay high school students report using electronic nicotine vapor products (ENDS) in the past 30 days, down from 8.7% in 2022.

Fewer East Bay high school students think ENDS are easy to get-43% in 2024 vs 51% in 2022.

#### MENTAL HEALTH INFORMATION

WITH REGIONAL DATA FROM THE RHODE ISLAND STUDENT SURVEY, 2024

34% of East Bay middle school students had mean rumors or lies spread about them at school (up from 30% in 2022), and 49% report being made fun of (up from 44% in 2022).





The percentage of East Bay high school students who have seriously considered suicide significantly decreased from 12% in 2022 to 10% in 2024.

45% of East Bay high school students (33% of middle school students) report spending 6 or more hours on their cell phones each day and many report that their cell phone use interferes with daily functioning.

### **ALCOHOL INFORMATION**

WITH REGIONAL DATA FROM THE RHODE ISLAND STUDENT SURVEY, 2024

Significantly fewer East Bay high school students have ever used alcohol, and, when they drink, they are consuming fewer drinks in a sitting.





More East Bay high school students believe their peers would disapprove using alcohol- 83% in 2024 vs **72%** in 2022.

13% of East Bay high school students have ridden in a vehicle driven by someone under the influence of alcohol.

#### **CANNABIS/MARIJUANA INFORMATION**

WITH REGIONAL DATA FROM THE RHODE ISLAND STUDENT SURVEY, 2024

Fewer East Bay high school students think it would be easy to obtain marijuana products to smoke or vape- 39% in 2024, down from 47% in 2022. (34% think marijuana edibles would be easy to obtain)





East Bay middle school student past 30-day use of marijuana held **steady** at 4.4% but, in the state of RI, middle school student marijuana use is actually **trending up**.

More East Bay high school students believe their parents would disapprove of them smoking or vaping marijuana- 88% in 2024 vs 82% in 2022.

#### OPIOID/STIMULANT INFORMATION

WITH REGIONAL DATA FROM THE RHODE ISLAND STUDENT SURVEY, 2024

A small number of East Bay high school students have ever misused prescription drugs such as those for pain relief, ADHD, and sedation and fewer do so in 2024 (3%) than they did in 2022 (4%).





76% of East Bay high school students believe people risk harming themselves if they use prescription drugs not prescribed to them.

Most East Bay high school students who use prescription drugs **not** prescribed to them reported obtaining them by **taking them** from someone.
